LOOKING BEHIND APRIL AND SPRING ...

Everything comes down to vibration and to a certain extent Numerology can be about defining how you vibrate personally, as well as how you vibrate in relation to your business, work and the significant events and people in your world. Vibrations are of course best defined by numbers and the letters that make up names and words each have the following vibration: -

1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 A B C D E F G H I J K L M N O P Q R S T U V W X Y Z

As well as the vibrations represented by the letters within a word or name, vowels (+Y) when added together represent 'Urge of Soul' or what we bring with us from previous lives, tools to help us complete our mission in this lifetime. Consonants represent 'Personality' or how others see us from the outside. Adding the vowels and consonants together, we get a vibration that represents our 'Overall Self Expression' or what we truly stand on in this lifetime - this vibration is there to help us to know ourselves and to make the best of what we already have.

The ancients used to believe that when you name something you make it sacred. Naming a person, business or thing defines a vibration and how ultimately that vibration connects to the much bigger picture.

The month of April heralds the beginning of spring, the beginning of the astrological year and symbolises rebirth. (Astrology has taken the northern hemisphere for its model).

Spring is traditionally the time of new growth.

In terms of numerology: -

11/2 represent's a channel of special awareness.

Energies beyond intellect coming through on the 2 of emotion, with the potential to inspire us all to think in new ways ...

29/ 11/ 2 represent's the 'birth of light' i.e. bit by bit inspiring others to think in new ways. The beginning of a process.

38/11/2 represent's inspiring others through your work. The end of a process

1 represents the initial fire like energy, naive but also unstoppable.

10/1 is the 1 after its journey from 1 to 9, full of light and possibilities, potentially a leader with great breadth of vision and compassion.

19/ 10/ 1 represent's the correct use of power and can mean a struggle to be independent and self confident, as pulled in different directions, 1 looking out for self and 9 wanting to help all of humanity. Ultimately this number is all about being a 'new age type of selfless leader' who takes everyone with you.

9 represents the end of a cycle and letting go with love, to make way for the new.

There is quite a journey represented here and looking another way we can see again that April is all about new beginnings.

APRIL

Combining both vowels and consonants the root or the place that the word April takes you to is 41/5 which represents 'the horn of plenty' in Numerology, that's spirit (1) coming into matter (4) then working together to shake everything up at every level, recognising what needs to change and attracting abundance in tangible ways.

Along the way: -

29/11/2 brings in the light, bit by bit inspiring many to think in new ways.

Wisdoms coming through on the 2 of emotion.

 $27/\,9$ is about wisdom from feelings and emotions, a new vision and long term commitment.

16/7 is all about relationships and working with others, ideally working for the highest good.

The journey to the 41/5 base can also be represented astrologically: -

Up to the 20th of April we have Aries and from the 21st of April we have Taurus.

Aries represents the beginning of all things and can represent the ego and the will without complication. Ruled by the energetic and fiery Mars this positive entity strives for the purest manifestation, it simply is. Aries can be very spontaneous, frank and open. But also innocent, inspiring awe and wonder. Aries needs to explore it's physical limits in order to develop properly, preferring action to contemplation. When their attempts to act are thwarted or delayed, the Aries personality can suffer acutely. Aries have a strong need to lead, but may lack the necessary leadership skills, so can get frustrated. At their best original and idealistic. (1)

i.e. to begin with just the bulb or seed sprouting or animals, perhaps newly born, returned from migration or awakened from hibernation, are all just concerned with their own survival. (1)

Taurus represents the second stage maintenance and the capacity to share i.e. not just about survival. This stage can bring flowers blossoming so bees can take their nectar and we can enjoy the scent of the flowers. (1)

Unlike Aries, Taureans do not crave constant activity, they enjoy repose and comfort. They also function as acute observers and can develop the capacity to contemplate and map out a strategy. Taureans enjoy being part of a team. (1)

Looking at the bigger picture ...

Combining both vowels and constantants the root or the place this takes you to is 14/5 which represents 'the messenger' in Numerology, (77/14/5 represents 'keeper of the silence' or the silent messenger that is spring).

38/11/2 inspiring us all with your work.

32/5 'crystalised sunshine' or making the vision real.

26/8 'Lord Karma' achieving success to help everyone.

11/2 A channel or awareness, to inspire us all to think in new ways.
