Unusual ways Numerology can be used

My standard consultations last for at least two hours and focuses on the client's 'piece of the puzzle' i.e. the reason for their unique set of circumstances, this can mean the lessons the are here to learn, the karma they have the opportunity to turn around in this lifetime, gifts, challenges, motivations, 'the key to their door', 'the impetus for their soul', the essence of who they are, 'what the world sees', the correlation between ability, motivation and opportunity....what can be realised with certain people are in their world, the mission that comes from their marriage/divorce, why their children chose them as a parent, why they chose their parents...and if this doesn't seem comprehensive enough, I have been blown away by some of the additional questions I have been asked. Obviously confidentiality is a big part of what I do, so below are some examples, based on my experience and in future newsletters I may provide further detail with regard to the examples below: -

Major and unexpected incidents have happened and my client wanted to know the reason why. Anyone who follows my 'every day in terms of Numerology' (which is updated daily on the blog on my website, Twitter and Facebook), will see how every day has its own unique energy patterns and characteristics. By putting the date of a major incident on my client's relationship chart, I am able to see how the incident may significantly change the dynamics of important relationships and may move the client more in the direction of their mission. There may be certain lessons to be learned and karma that may need to be viewed in a new way. Every date generates a mission, a first and second goal, lessons, a gift, a challenge as well as many other characteristics and patterns including karma, so there is a great deal to discuss, but the 'Relationship Chart' communicates and illustrates very succinctly all the numbers and the patterns they generate, can communicate.

A good day to take my driving test?

Certain dates can help us to complete what we are here to do and can help to move our life in the direction of our mission. When I am given a selection of dates, I can analyse the impact of each date and advise the date most compatible with a client's personal numbers and the date that will most help them to complete what they are here to do. I applied this analysis recently when a client had a selection of dates to choose from with regard to her driving test – and yes the person passed their driving test first time...

Help me to choose a number plate for my new car?

The number plate of your car can be reduced to a number, when you add up the actual numbers and the numbers that corresponds to each letter. When I compare this number with the core numbers in a client's chart, I can confirm the number plate most compatible the client's personality and mission.

The significance of my phone number, email address, website?

Phone numbers (without their code) are unique and each number has its own characteristics and energy, the same can be true of email addresses and website names. Certain energies i.e. 8 are good for business others i.e. 3 are good for fun and scattering your energy. If you are planning to set up your own business, it can be a good idea to have contact details that are compatible with the energy you want your business to promote, especially when the name of your business and your contact details may be the only information a potential client may have to go on initially.

The significance of different house numbers in my life?

House numbers and names also represent certain energies and characteristics. Many clients report the significance of certain numbers during specific periods in their life and the energies and happenings around certain house numbers and names.

What name should I give my new pet?

The right name for your pet can emphasise the good qualities in their behaviour. The energy resulting from the name given can be made also to be compatible with that of the owner and possibly the energy of the house too..

Finding Lost Objects?

Every action you take and every observation you make, whether consciously, or distractedly, is permanently stored somewhere in your subconscious.

Numerology can help you to take advantage of the vast storage room of information your subconscious contains by offering you a unique retrieval system.

Let's say, you have lost a ring. The only thing you know for sure is that you were there when you last had the ring in your possession.

Perhaps it fell out of your pocket, which caused a barely noticeable decrease in weight, or made a quiet "ploink" when it hit the carpet and rolled under the couch.

Or you put it somewhere and forgot it. Whatever happened, you do not discover the loss of your ring until several days later.

The moment you lost the ring, however, is stored in your subconscious.

The way to tap into that source is by exercising your subconscious.

Step 1

Write down 9 numbers you may repeat same number many times a you like in make line of 9 numbers.

Step 2

Add all the numbers together

Step 3

Add 3 to the total.

Answers

- 1 it is in the your bedroom or the room you spend most of your time. Near something white also question a child if he/she was around, use your discretion here.
- 2 Might have left near a vase or bowl (container) while someone was cleaning.
- 3 It has fallen in the passage or between papers or a book etc.
- 4 Check the pockets of what you wore last.
- 5 Its near a hat or helmet.

- 6 It's in the shoe closet or near a rack or stand. Also check the shelves nearby also.
- 7 Check your wardrobe and question your partner or spouse.
- 8 A workman knows where it is, possibility on the edge of a ledge.
- 9 A child was playing with it.
- 10 Check your study or office.
- 11 It's near water check the pool, bathroom or water dispenser if at work.
- 12 It's in the office either inside a book or some papers.
- 13 Look where hung your coat last and/or behind or under chair or desk.
- 14 it may have fallen in the drain outside or in the bathroom recovery is doubtful, perhaps check also where hats and helmets are stored.
- 15 Check your garage and if you own horses check your stables as well. Failing this ask your partner or spouse.
- 16. If you have had an argument with your spouse or partner, they may have found the object and are waiting to give you a piece of their mind.
- 17 If you have artwork or paint check here. Also check your jewellery box.
- 18 It's in your house among some clothes and if went on trip check your suitcase.
- 19 It's either in a child's sand box or the park. Mostly a dry area with no vegetation, if you went to beach recently it might be there....good luck
- 20 It's near water and this can mean near a swimming pool or near the pool's changing room.
- 21. It's in a square or rectangular shaped box that folds in two parts, like some old Jewellery boxes.
- 22 It's in the house near shelve i.e. book shelves.
- 23. It's in the laundry room.
- 24 Check your pockets again or briefcase thoroughly.
- 25 It's near something white and round a large serving platter perhaps.
- 27. Perhaps ask your taxi driver one send them the lost item as a reward.
- 28 Accept the loss of the item and it may be replaced.
- 29 An old trusted sub-servant person who respects you i.e. your cleaner may have it.
- 30 Some kids may have found this while playing.
- 31 It's near a drain or dark area i.e. the dark corner of a closet.
- 32 It's on a balcony and about to fall.
- 33 Check again the pockets of something you just wore
- 34 It's near a heater or fireplace
- 35 It's near a washing stand, water fountain or in a hidden area near some water.

- 36 Ask the nanny.
- 37 It's fallen in a temple or church.
- 38 It's in a place where you go to meditate prey or unwind. If you are a teenager it's in the place you drink with your friends.
- 39 Its on the table or shelf where you were busy last.
- 40 If it's a small item, check inside your handkerchief or check near linen you were with last or just bought.
- 41 It's near your spouse or partner's shoe.
- 42 Ask your spouse or partner again.
- 43 Check again your garage or stables.
- 44 It's fallen in something oily perhaps while you were working on your car.
- 45 It's on a shelf higher than you can see, making it just out of sight.
- 46 It may be with your partner.
- 47 It may be with someone with whom you have bad relations.
- 48 It's near a glass of water
- 49 It maybe lost and badly damaged
- 50 It's inside something that opens in two parts.
- 51 Try looking in your bathroom.
- 52 Your wife or partner may have lent this to a relative.
- 53 A friend has found it and will return it.
- 54. Try the children's playroom.
- 55 Its near a pipe or drain around your home.
- 56. Check where you parked the car last.
- 57. If you fish it's near your fishing bag.
- 58 Two rogues may have taken it ...
- 59. Near the bread tin or where the flour is kept.
- 60 It's beyond recovery, because whoever has found it either doesn't know you or refuses to return it.
- 61 It's in your basement or shed near shoes or a hose.
- 62 It's lost.
- 63 It's in a dark place in the corner near old articles.
- 64 It will turn up when you are searching for something else in the near future.
- 65 You may need assistance in recovering this as in the case of a stolen car.
