

## The Man Who Transcended Form ...

The world is mourning the loss of British cosmologist Stephen William Hawking, who was born in England on the 8<sup>th</sup> of January 1942 - 300 years to the day after the death of the astronomer Galileo Galilei. He attended University College, Oxford, where he studied physics, despite his father's urging to focus on medicine. He is best known for his contributions to the fields of cosmology, general relativity and quantum gravity, especially in the context of black holes. His discoveries have made the detailed study of black holes possible. Professor Hawking also published many books tackling the fundamental questions about the universe and our existence, as well as many scientific papers and lecture notes. His book 'A Brief History of Time' is an internationally acclaimed masterpiece and in this article we will explore what numerology can tell us about him...

Stephen Hawking's mission is determined from his date of birth (8/1/1942): -

His First Goal =  $(8+1) = 9/9$   
His Challenge =  $(1+9+4+2) = 16/7$   
His Mission =  $25/16/7$

Stephen's First Goal (9) is ultimately about the completion of something. 9s hold all the experiences from 1 to 8, so have great wisdom, but must learn to give this knowledge out. 9s can also be perfectionists who can see the potential in everything, but they have to learn detachment and to be humble, as they are ultimately here in service and have to learn to let go of all that is unproductive so they can focus on helping humanity.

Stephen was born on the 8<sup>th</sup> of January, this can be represented by 81/9, the number of the initiate who re-evaluates (8) with great will power (1) how best to help humanity (9). There are also 9 sets of 9 in 81, this represents lots of endings as well as great wisdom, but also his lack of attachment to illusion, as well as his selfless giving and his ability to survive the 'nothing times'.

A large part of Stephen's mission and his challenge was powerful 16/7 energy, which can bring a great deal of transience and change. The universe was encouraging him to find the treasure within and so help others to do this (card 16 in the Tarot represents 'The Tower'). In the words of his friend and fellow astro-physicist Neil deGrasse Tyson "We are in the universe and the universe is in us".

The 6 in the 16/7 also has a zero behind it, emphasising a great sense of responsibility towards others, rather than the 1 which focusses more on the self. As a challenge this may have meant that sharing his understandings and helping others may have become more important to Stephen as he got older.

The 25 prefixing the 16/7 of Stephen's mission represents progressive thinking, the 5 here has a zero behind it, bringing in the potential for the higher mind to adapt to change. This 5 is born of great emotion and sensitivity (20/2). As well as extreme sensitivity this can mean the 'Birth of Consciousness' as mind (5), heart and feelings (2) come together. They can be represented by looking at the shape of the 25<sup>th</sup> letter 'Y' which can be seen as a funnel focussing his considerable energy, so as to channel it down to earth and to the root of things. There is great sharpness of mind here and a potential to apply powerful wisdoms in a practical and physical way. This may have helped Stephen to stay one step ahead and so bring order to chaos, creating routines, acting on feelings of compassion and being of service to others.

Using a different approach, Stephen's Date of Birth can also reduce to 97/ 16/ 7 (as is illustrated below): -

The 6 in the 16/ 7 of Stephen's mission and Challenge may mean that Stephen had a great sense of responsibility towards others and his personal intent (33/ 6) further emphasises this. Stephen's 'Personal Intent' could have meant that he went the extra mile for others, not wanting to let others down and this may have opened doors for him, but could also have meant that he felt responsible for the happiness of others, to such an extent that he could give too much. ('Personal Intent' is the quality that would help him to self-realise).

Stephen's 'Personality No.' or 'the essence of who he was' (65/ 11/ 2) represents a prolific creator, the higher mind (5) born of his great sense of responsibility (6). This may have motivated him to work with the group, for the group. The 65/ 11/2 can also represent a prolific creator capable of inspired communication, whilst the 11/ 2 represents a channel directly linked with the spiritual and giving him a potential to inspire others to think in new ways. The double 1 represents great will power, fire and passion coming down on the 2 of emotion. This can mean breadth of vision and the potential to exude great confidence and charisma that may not have been felt inside.

Stephen's 'Soul Urge' or motivation number as he got older (39/ 12/ 3) can represent a massive letting go as the 9 here has a zero behind it. This can mean giving something up to serve a bigger or higher purpose. That his brilliant mind was always on the go may have led to difficulty connecting with mundane reality, yet motivated him to communicate profound truths in accessible effective way.

Stephen's 'Overall Self Expression No.' or 'how the world saw him' (23/ 5) represents great creativity (3) born of great sensitivity and emotion (20/ 2). This can bring extremes of emotion and may have meant both his thoughts and intuition could move very quickly. 23/ 5 is about capturing the light and grounding it. It was important for Stephen therefore to stay focussed on what he loved and practical in how applied this. Obstacles could have been seen as positive as they kept his energies grounded and focussed. The twenty third letter of the alphabet is 'W' and this illustrates how Stephen's life may have had more ups and downs than most, taking him deep into matter but also high into spirit. He may have had a great need for mobility and to fly. That he achieved this through his mind may have been a great inspiration to many.

Stephen's 'Spiritual Fusion No.' combines what was here to do with his personal intent, (the quality that helps him to self-realise) and this may have brought everything together for Stephen: -

His Mission = 25/ 16/ 7  
His Personal Intent = 33/ 6/ 6  
His Spiritual Fusion No. 58/ 22/ 13/ 4

This number shows how his great adaptability and ability to deal with change (5), combined with his ability to re-evaluate (8) and push himself to his limits (13/ 4), created great opportunities for growth and change. Card 13 in the Tarot represents 'Death' and 13/ 4 in Numerology represents a great potential for rebirth and transformation. The 3 (with a zero behind it) amplifies great self-expression and creativity. This has the potential to break open the 4, shaking things up to get things moving, bringing change rebirth and transformation. The 58/ 22/ 13/ 4 energy can result in obstacles and other people trying to impose their way of thinking, but this may have been positive for Stephen as it kept him grounded, focussed and connected to others. The 22/ 4 energy represents the 'master builder', building with love (22) and great breadth of vision as well as great attention to detail, (one 2 here has a zero behind it, bringing in great love/wisdom, the higher quality of the 2 of emotion). This could mean inner change, rebirth and transformation which may have resulted in the big projects conducted by Stephen.

Stephen's core numbers include the line of the 'Enquirer (and Sceptic)'. This is a line that many scientists share and indicates Stephen may have reacted with great scepticism to anything new, but once he investigated a concept and proved it to himself his scepticism could turn into strong belief. Where he disagreed with the concept, he may have discarded this forever.

The mission that comes from the date of Stephen's passing (14/3/2018) is 28/ 10/ 1: -

His First Goal = (14+3) = 17/ 8  
His Challenge = (2+1+8) = 11/ 2  
His Mission = 28/ 10/ 1

28/ 10/ 1 represents 'Who Dares Wins' and is about finding the courage to be a true pioneer.

The first goal that comes from this date (17/ 8) represents seeking out the truth and getting to the bottom of things. (In the grid for this date there is a line of passion and determination and the job to be done is also a 17/ 8, so this emphasises this quality). 17/ 8 represents 'God and his Creature' as the will of man (1) has the potential to connect to the spiritual realms (7) and a much greater truth, no longer trapped in matter, but connected to spirit, which is without limits. The seventeenth letter 'Q' can represent spiritual wholeness, with a 'sticking point' the tail, determined to stay connected to the earth and matter, while stubbornly looking for truth.

The challenge that comes from the year of this date (2+1+8 = 11/ 2) represents connecting to the bigger picture and being open to new ways of thinking. The sum of the numbers missing from this date (18/ 9) represent using true feelings to see clearly in all situations and seeing sensitivity as strength. (The alternative - this may be sabotage).

From this date 82/ 10/ 1 is also generated (as is illustrated bellow): -

82/ 10/ 1 represents 'The will to implement the wisdom of the new consciousness'.  
The 14/ 5 at the start of this date represents the messenger breaking out of the box, using all 5 senses to find truth. The 53/ 8 which then emerges signifies great creativity (3) born of change (5) and success (8) through surviving.

Stephen passed away age 76, this can be reduced to 76/ 13/ 4, which represents new solutions to old problems and a new foundation for reinvention. This may be found in his many books, scientific papers and lecture notes - his amazing legacy for the world...

On the 'Relationship Chart' we can see that central to Stephen's life was the 1, which represents great will power to survive, by acting as a pioneer and initiating a new way of thinking. We can see he was open but needed other people to help connect his spiritual and academic knowledge (7) with success in the material realm, the 8 changing patterns that will otherwise go on forever (the 8 never stops moving and represents balancing the spiritual and the physical).

The date of Stephen's passing (14/3/18) takes us to a different place, rather than starting with the 8 of changing patterns that would otherwise go on forever, the starting point here is 14/ 5, which represents communicating his truth. Central to this date is the gift of communication and creativity (3) as well as the challenge (11/ 2) which is to allow ourselves to be inspired to think in new ways. The mission that comes from this date (28/ 10/ 1) takes us back to the central point of Stephen's life and his gift (1), which was about being an independent, self-achieving pioneer. The mission that comes from his passing (28/ 10/ 1) takes us beyond this to 'who dares wins' and the courage to do things in new ways. The lines generated from the date of his passing are very open indicating that it is now up to us to connect changing the way that we think, with our survival. This is something we all need to be doing very quickly and while Stephen is no longer with us physically, his legacy continues to inspire us all !!
